USEFUL sentences

Where are you travelling / flying to?

How long is the flight?

Places

- lounge:** place to wait, sit and relax
- check-in desk / check-in counter**
- departures area/ arrivals area**
- gates:** where you board the plane
- carousel / baggage claim:** where you pick up your bags
- on the plane:** cabin / cockpit / wings + tail of the plane
- runway:** big road on which the plane takes off and lands

Phrasal verbs

- Drop off** - to take someone to a place and leave them there
- Check in** - to register at a hotel
- Check out** - to leave and pay for your stay at a hotel
- Pick up** - to go and fetch someone from a place and take them somewhere else
- Set out** - to start a journey
- Take off** - when a plane leaves and begins to fly
- Get in** - when a plane arrives on an airport
- Get away** - to leave to go somewhere for a break or holiday
- Get on** - to climb on board
- Speed up** - to increase speed
- Look around** - to explore what is near you, in your area
- See off** - to go to the place someone is leaving from to say goodbye
- Look forward** - when you can't wait for something to happen
- Go back** - go to the place you left



Items and objects

- suitcase - luggage - bags - baggage**
- carry-on luggage / handbag / personal belongings - items**
- passport / ID / flight ticket / boarding pass**
- tray / X-ray / metal detector**
- life jacket / oxygen mask / seatbelt**
- aisle seat / window seat**
- overhead lockers**
- TV screen / headsets - headphones - earphones**
